



WEB ACCESSIBILITY CHECKLIST

Structure & Semantics

- Use semantic HTML elements
- One clear H1 per page
- Proper heading hierarchy (H1–H6)
- Lists built with proper list elements
- Tables used only for tabular data with headers
- Landmark regions defined

Keyboard Accessibility

- All functionality usable with keyboard only
- Logical tab order
- Visible focus indicators
- No keyboard traps
- Skip-to-content link included



Color & Contrast

- Text contrast ratio meets WCAG standards
- Interactive elements meet contrast requirements
- Information not conveyed by color alone
- Links visually distinguishable

Images & Media

- Descriptive alt text for meaningful images
- Decorative images use empty alt attributes
- Captions provided for videos
- Transcripts available for audio
- No auto-playing media with sound
- Media controls keyboard accessible

Forms & Inputs

- Every input has an associated label
- Required fields clearly identified
- Clear and accessible error messages
- Errors programmatically associated with fields
- Field instructions provided before submission
- Accessible CAPTCHA alternative available

Responsive & Zoom

- Layout responsive across devices
- Text resizable up to 200%
- No horizontal scrolling at small widths
- Content does not overlap when zoomed



ARIA & Dynamic Content

- ARIA used only when necessary
- ARIA roles and states correctly implemented
- Dynamic updates announced to screen readers
- Modals manage focus correctly

Navigation & Interaction

- Consistent navigation across pages
- Descriptive page titles
- Descriptive link text
- Breadcrumbs used where appropriate
- Adjustable or removable time limits

Content & Readability

- Clear, plain language used
- Instructions not dependent on sensory cues
- Abbreviations explained
- No flashing or seizure-triggering content

Testing & Compliance

- Keyboard-only testing completed
- Screen reader testing completed
- Automated accessibility scan completed
- Manual accessibility review completed
- WCAG 2.1 AA standards met
